**Applied Science and Technology Source is a resource found in EBSCOhost. It contains indexing and abstracts for core English-language, scientific and technical publications back to 1983 with some full text back to 1997. Content includes a wide variety of applied science specialties such as acoustics, aeronautics, civil engineering, computers, informatics, neural networks, nuclear engineering and much more. Content is drawn from leading trade/industrial journals, professional/technical society journals, specialized subject periodicals, buyers' guides, directories and conference proceedings. Science faculty and students will find this a very helpful resource.**

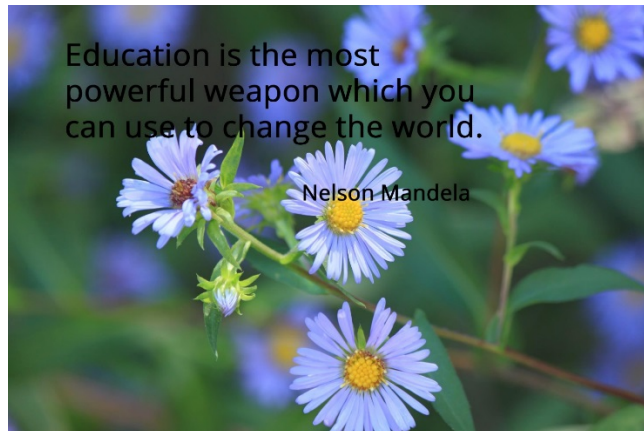
