FEATURED DATABASE:

Art & Architecture Source is a resource found in EBSCOhost. It covers a broad range of related subjects from fine, decorative and commercial art to various areas of architecture and architectural design. It includes access to full-text journals (both trade and scholarly), books and a collection of over 63,000 images. In addition to being able to search journal articles, book reviews and biographies, the user can also search images. The Image Quick View limit will return both black & white and color images. High resolution images are available. Of course, the PDF full text of articles will also have B/W and color photographs of art works where the author has included these. These images are not searchable but are embedded in the PDF file. They are discoverable when viewing the PDF full text. Another interesting feature is the access to web news items which is provided as part of the results set. These web news links will take the user outside of the database to related web sources. This resource will be of great interest to art, art history and graphic design students and faculty.

The Writing Center is now located inside the Library, as part of Madonna's Academic Support Space. Take advantage of the services the Writing Center has to offer.

The Writing Center Staff can review your papers and guide you along the way. Don't procrastinate. They will not accept you on the day your paper is due.
