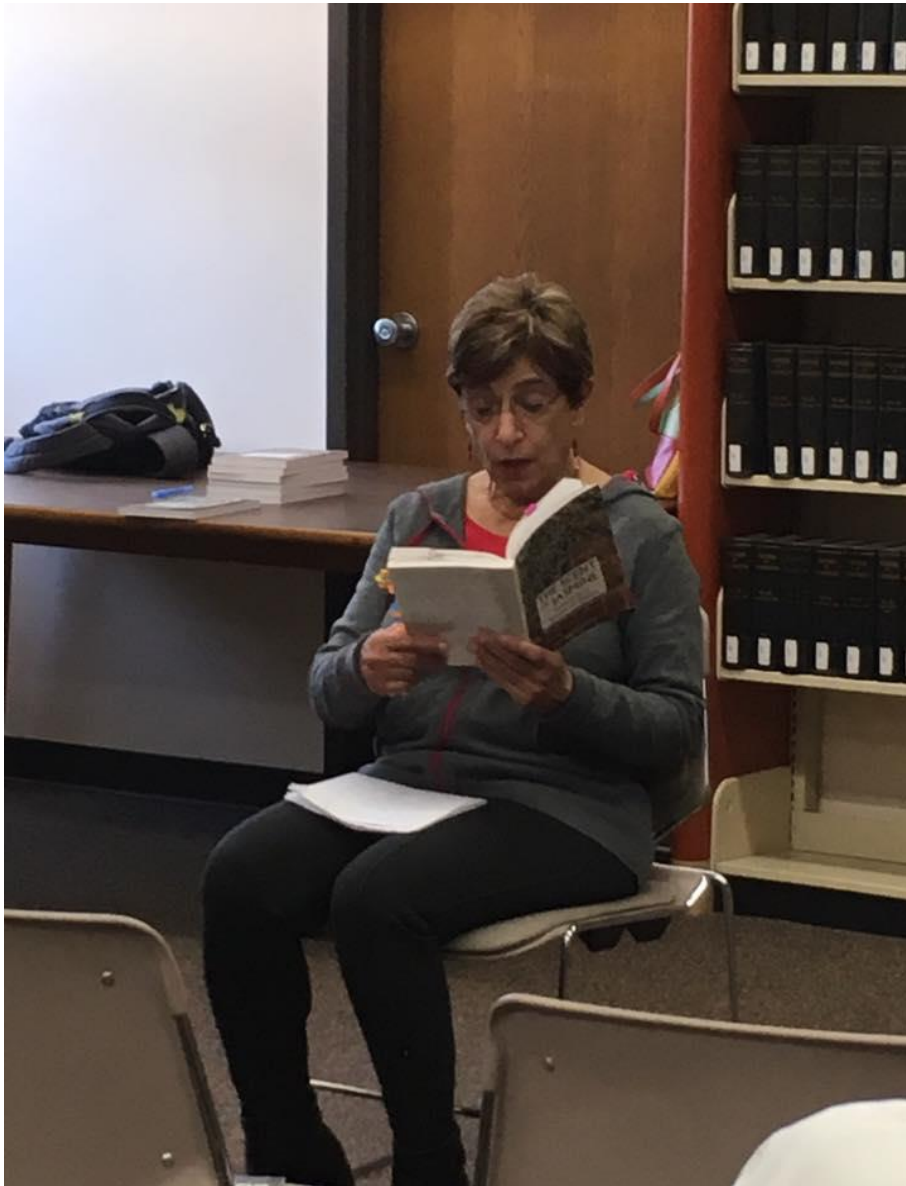

Featured Database: Access Medicine

AccessMedicine is an online comprehensive resource for medical and nursing students. It connects students to examination/procedural videos, patient safety modules, audio files/animations of fundamental medical concepts, self-assessment/study tools and leading medical textbooks. Various tools in the resource include a differential diagnosis tool (Diagnosaurus), practice guidelines, diagnostic tests and Quick Medical Dx & Rx. Other features include the 2 Minute Medicine curated news service, customizable patient education handouts, an integrated drug database, downloadable images to aid in visual diagnosis and case files. Nursing faculty and students will find that this resource provides a window into the real world, clinical environment of nursing and medical practice.
